Presbyterian Women Thank Offering Service

On November 25 and 26, First Presbyterian Women will be leading a “Healing of the Nations” worship service. This worship service joyfully celebrates the Presbyterian Women’s Thank Offering. Thank Offering funds provide education, safe housing, clean water, health care, help for prisoners and justice for women programs. One of the 2017 international programs that is receiving funds is the African Inland Church Dispensary in Kisumu, Kenya. For 100 years, the Nyakach dispensary has offered medical services and education to impoverished and underserved women and families in the Rift Valley. Thank Offering funds will provide structural equipment and administrative upgrades so the dispensary can continue to serve and grow. This recipient request was submitted by Trisha Tull and endorsed by First Prez PW and Presbyterian Women of the Presbytery of Ohio Valley. There are 15 Thank Offering projects; ten of the projects are national and five are international and more than half of the projects are health ministries. Presbyterian women have been making grants to creative ministries through the Thank Offering since 1888 when Eliza Clokey of Springfield, OH urged women to give one dollar over and above their usual contribution to the Women’s General Missionary Society of the United Presbyterian Church of North America as a “thank offering to our Lord.”

Those attending First Presbyterian will have an opportunity to donate to this offering and support these life-changing ministries. Presbyterian Women are grateful to the finance and mission committees and to the session for their support of this worship service and extra-commitment offering.
